The different air-cushion soles at a glance

Our feet are unique. There are countless shapes, sizes and other factors that determine whether a shoe fits and is comfortable. Our shoes have different types of soles to offer as many people as possible the unique feeling of the kybun air-cushion shoe:



Sole type

Strato, Strato Outdoor II, Sandal, Sandal Special

This type of sole offers maximum impact, optimal cushioning as well as the greatest possible training success. It distributes the foot pressure evenly, optimises the transmission of forces and compensates for relieving postures and misalignments. The elastic springy material and the continuous sole profile offer optimal grip on any surface. The integrated air cylinders ensure continuous ventilation and a pleasant foot climate.



Sole type

Tropo with slight trampoline effect

The sole type "Tropo" offers a slightly reduced intensity and effect. It is ideally suited for people with muscle weakness or balance disorders. It is also ideal for movement enthusiasts who do not want to miss the kybun shoe during sports. Although the sole does not have air cylinders, it does have the proven kybun grip on all surfaces.

An ingenious idea – born in Korea's rice fields

The origin of kybun is the Swiss engineer Karl Müller III. He invented the ground-breaking air cushion technology and laid the foundation for the company that today designs and manufactures the innovative kybun shoes and mats.

The entrepreneur found his inspiration in South Korea in the 1990s. There he experienced at first hand how pleasant it was to walk on the resilient clay soil of the rice fields. This healing effect on the entire musculoskeletal system motivated Müller to devote all his creative energy to the development and refinement of this technology.

The heart of all kybun products is the elastic air cushion. It keeps the foot constantly in motion while standing and walking and thereby stimulates the muscles throughout the body. This promotes strength and coordination at the same time.

Sit less – live better

Long and frequent sitting also has a negative impact on our bodies – back pain, muscle atrophy and poor circulation are the consequences.

With the kybun mat, you can make your everyday life more dynamic and healthier from now on. Whether at the workplace, while ironing or in the home office. Thanks to the impulse-active crumple zone in our kybun mats, the foot sinks deeply and then springs back like on a trampoline. When standing on the kybun mat, you thus challenge your body to fine, permanent activity. The springy effect also causes alternating muscle tension and relaxation. This trains the leg, foot and back muscles. Without any additional time investment, the kybun mat improves your balance, coordination and general fitness.
